

Highlights of the October 20, 2015 Vestry Meeting

These are the highlights of the October 20th Vestry Meeting.

A grant was received for the window replacement for the six windows in the hallway in front of the offices and the three windows in the offices. The replacements will be fixed windows without operating sashes.

A bicycle rack has been purchased and Kyle King and Dennis Marsh are to pour the concrete for mounting the rack.

Kyle King and Harry Strait are mostly finished repairing and re-finishing the front wooden doors of the Church.

The sustainable budget was reviewed and discussed by the vestry members. Two committees will be formed to create an Income and Expense Statement. Lauren will head the expense portion and Diane will head the income portion. A rough draft of these statements is due by the November 24th vestry meeting so it can be reviewed and then presented to the congregation at the annual meeting in January. A three year budget is necessary to call a priest.

The Camp Foundation is donating \$15,000 per year to St. Paul's for this year and 2016.

The Treasurer's report for September was reviewed and discussed. A payment of \$30,000 to the Holy Spirit Hall mortgage pay down will be applied in October. This payment will take the mortgage note to under \$400,000 owed on the building.

The next vestry meeting is Tuesday, November 24th. Anyone is welcome to attend.
