

Vestry Highlights from 4-18-17

Phil Rowland presented the vestry with an update regarding our piano. While it has been maintained, our piano does not have a very good sound. He suggested that we think about investing in a good piano that would last a very long time. He is willing to donate the first \$1,000.00 toward this. The cost of a new grand piano is approximately \$20,000.00. The vestry passed a motion to use \$3,000.00 from the Helen Gillooly bequest to start a piano fund. The vestry has also asked the treasurer to look into income that may be available from the Brooks fund which is designated for music. As a reminder, the organ will be down in July for repairs.

Quarterly ministry planning meetings will be re-instituted in an effort to better plan and coordinate parish events. The first meeting with ministry chairs will be on May 7th after church.

The Search Committee started interviewing this week. They have 5 interviews scheduled. These should be completed by the 29th. The application window is now closed.

A detailed proposal explaining the repairs and updates that are needed for our sound system was presented to the vestry. The vestry approved moving forward with this asap.

The next Vestry meeting is May 16th and everyone is welcome to attend.
